I Have read the below rules and agree to abide by these rules when making use of the facilities at Potchefstroom Country Club.

1. Membership.

- 1.1 Any member who has failed to pay his/her annual subscription on or before the 1st of September of each year shall be precluded from booking any court or participating in any social event or tournament at the Club until his/her subscription has been settled in full.
- 1.2 The Committee has the Authority to deactivate the transponder of any member failing to abide by the terms of bye law 1.1.
- 1.3 The Committee and or the treasurer shall have the right to determine any request by any member to settle his/her annual membership fee in installments. This is subject to the member so applying is

in good standing and all installments must be received prior to the end of the Club's financial year being the 30th of August of each year.

2. Defrauding.

- 2.1 Only members and their guests may use this facility.
- A member may bring a guest and pay a R30 visitor fee per 45 minutes in cash to the bar or paid with lights account.
- 2.3 Members found defrauding the system by allowing "non members" to use their transponder, in their absence, will be banned from the club and their transponder will be deactivated.

3. League Practice and Social.

- 3.1 During block bookings for league practice and social squash, the courts are for the use of paid up members of Potchefstroom Country Club only.
- 3.2 Players gain access to a court on a "first come, first served" basis during social squash.
- 3.3 Social squash on Saturdays takes place from 13:00 15:00 with players rotating courts and opponents. Social events may be arranged by a committee member for a fee to cover lights and for fundraising purposes.
- 3.4 Days and times:
 - -- Saturday Socials on a Saturday from 13:00 15:00
 - -- Organised social tournaments on a Wednesday in the off season from 18:00-20:00
 - -- League on a Wednesday evening during league season from 18:00 22:00.

4. Attire and Equipment.

- 4.1 Unacceptable footwear for squash is:
 - 4.1.1 running shoes, black soled shoes, cross trainers or integrated coloured soles
- 4.2 Acceptable footwear for squash is:
 - 4.2.1 clear soles, gum rubber soles or white soled shoes.
- 4.3 The committee reserves the right to refuse any member or visitor the use of the courts unless appropriate footwear is used. A R1000 fine will be given to anyone not adhering to this rule.
- 4.4 Light coloured protection tape for racquet heads is preferred as dark coloured tape marks the walls.

5. Booking rules.

- 5.1 You may book a court online via our GoBook app.
- 5.2 Players will not be allowed to book double sessions during peak time of 16:30 19:00.
 - If a player is 10 minutes late for a booking, that booking is forfeited and the court may be used by other players.
 - A penalty will be charged to the defaulter's account
- 5.2 Light fees are R25 for 45 minutes and will be shared by two people booking provided each swipe their tag. Players must book and adhere to the allocated time slots for the sake of members
 - booked before and after them. Your booking may not infringe on another member's booking Time.
- 5.3 The person who has made the booking needs to swipe their tag first otherwise the system sees it as a new booking and a no show and therefore a penalty will be charged.

6. Ball Machine

- 6.1 Ball machines may only be used between 12:00 and the last session 17:15 on weekdays.
- 6.2 A credit will be bought for R50 cash for 45 minutes at the bar.
- 6.3 Players using the ball machine for the first time to contact Cara Fourie for instructions.
- 6.4 Players to sign the machine in and out in the book at PCC
- 6.5 Players who are not members at PCC using the ball machine will need to pay an additional R20 visitor fee
- Responsibility of the machine is only transferred at the time of the next players' usage. The player using the machine, is responsible for it until such time it is signed out by the next player
